Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, no offence is made out against the petitioner. The only role attributed to her is that a sum of Rupees one lac was deposited in her account on instructions from her son.

Learned State counsel submits that the bank statement of the petitioner has been verified, which shows that the aforementioned sum of Rupees one lac, has been deposited in her account.

Thus, it is clear that the petitioner did not make any representation to the complainant for depositing money in her account.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to join investigation on 26.06.2018 at 10:00 A.M. and shall continue to do so as and when required by the Investigating Agency. In the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the A.O./I.O./S.H.O. concerned subject to her compliance of provisions enshrined under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
