The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 564 dated 21.04.2018 registered under Section 67-A of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Sections 195-A, 506 IPC, at Police Station City, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 21.04.2018 and the investigation is complete but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as 04 more PWs remain to be examined. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner except for an FIR got registered by the complainant of the present case itself with similar allegations and the petitioner is on bail in the said case. The complainant has already been examined and thus, there can be no apprehension of the petitioner interfering with the evidence or the trial.

The aforementioned factual submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner are not controverted by the learned State counsel.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, at Panipat.
