Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner after having been duly given permission by the President of the Gurukul at Kurukshetra (respondent no. 6) on 01.09.2014, to display his electrical device at Gurukul, is not now being returned the device and instead was beaten up on 04.11.2017, when he went to collect it.

On the next day, i.e. 05.11.2017, in fact an FIR was got registered against the petitioner at the instance of one Rakesh Jain, who contends that in fact it was he and the petitioner who had entered into a partnership on 03.09.2011, qua invention of the aforesaid device.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a complaint by way of an e-mail to the Additional Director General of Police (Law & Order), Haryana (respondent no. 3) and the Additional Director General of Police (Crime), Haryana (respondent no. 2), a copy of which is shown to be Annexure P-6 with the petition.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Additional Director General of Police (Crime), Haryana (respondent no. 2), to go into the grievance of the petitioner after giving him a due hearing, and to take action as per law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It needs to be noticed that a copy of the written permission stated to have been given by respondent no. 6 to the petitioner, has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition, with learned counsel further submitting that the signatures of the petitioner on the so called partnership deed were forged.

No comment on merits is made on the aforesaid contentions, which would be gone into by the ADGP (Crime) and a decision taken, as per law, by the officer.
