Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0067 dated 07.04.2018 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149, 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, following order was passed on 11.06.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, petitioner No.1 had given a datar blow on the left shoulder of injured Mika and petitioner No.2 had given daat blow on the left arm of the injured. It is further submitted that as per MLR, none of the injury was found to be grievous in nature and without obtaining opinion of the doctor, Section 307 IPC has been invoked. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that from the petitioners’ side, one Inderjit Kaur wife of petitioner No.1 also

sustained injuries and she has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 24.05.2018 passed in CRM-M-22271-2018. It is also submitted that it is a case of version and cross-version and a DDR has also been registered in this regard.

Notice of motion for 18.07.2018.”

Thereafter, one another opportunity was granted to the petitioners to join the investigation vide order dated 18.07.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid orders, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 11.06.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
