This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar (Rural), vide FIR No.52 dated 13.05.2017.

The FIR was registered on the basis of complaint made by Daljit Singh. He alleged that on 28.10.2016, he had gone to Bhind Kiryana Store for purchasing grocery. At about 9/10.00 P.M., all the accused assaulted him and caused various injuries. Kulwant Singh and Bhinderjit Singh @ Pinderjit Singh were armed with sharp edged weapons and inflicted serious injuries. Injuries No.1 & 2 were declared dangerous to life. Both Kulwant Singh and Bhinderjit Singh @ Pinderjit Singh are alleged to have inflicted injuries by a '*Sua*'.

Under the circumstances, this court feels that in view of nature

of allegations levelled against petitioners No.1 & 2, they are not entitled to concession of anticipatory bail. The petition qua petitioners No.1 & 2 is hereby dismissed. However, learned State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated July 12, 2017, petitioners No.3 & 4 have joined the investigation and have cooperated. Thus, the interim order dated July 12, 2017 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed qua petitioners No.3 & 4 in aforesaid terms.
