Petitioners-Aditya Vikram Newar and Santosh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.517 dated 20.09.2017, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the present case, the petitioners have been found innocent by the police and cancellation report has been prepared by the police.

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Learned State counsel agrees to the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the petitioners.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 01.02.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case especially in view of the fact that the police has prepared cancellation report, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 01.02.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
