It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are being harassed and humiliated by respondent No.4 at the behest of respondent No.5. He, however, conceded that there is an FIR registered against the son of petitioner No.2 but he has been granted bail in the said FIR. He further states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued that in case the petitioners are required for the purpose of investigation/enquiry, they be called by adopting the proper procedure.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to Inspector, P.S. Division No.2, District Ludhiana-respondent No.4 that in case the petitioners are required for the purpose of investigation/enquiry, they be given a proper notice under Section 160 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
