Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.80 dated 26.05.2018 under Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 12.06.2018: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, recovery of the liquor was made from a car, which was parked in a vacant plot and the petitioner was not arrested at the spot.

Notice of motion for 04.09.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

order dated 12.06.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardam Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.06.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
