AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court praying for providing security to the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 4 to 6. Respondent No. 4, who is father of petitioner No. 1, is present in Court and he states that he, along with his son-respondent No. 5, would not cause any harm to the petitioners in any manner. He further states that the only intention of the parents is to meet their daughter. His further submission is that an opportunity may be given by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kaithal or the Station House Officer, Police Station Kaithal for the said purpose.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have already submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kaithal-

respondent No. 2 dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-4), a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kaithal as also the Station House Officer, Police Station Kaithal , respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively, to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, in case there is any threat from respondents No. 4 to 6 despite an undertaking having been given by respondent No. 4 in Court and an endeavour shall also be made to facilitate one meeting between the petitioners and Shishpal Sharma-respondent No. 4, father of petitioner No. 1, in the police station.

Petition stands disposed of with above directions.
