AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are being harassed and humiliated by respondent Nos.4 and 5 without any reason as there is neither any case or complaint registered against them. He further states that the petitioners are not averse to joining the enquiry/investigation in case there is any complaint against them but their house is being raided without any basis simply because the son of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 is in bad company. Counsel states that the petitioners have no grievance in case a proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. is given to them for joining investigation/enquiry, if required.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon and keeping in view the statement of counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with an observation that in case the petitioners are required for any enquiry/investigation, they be given proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.
