The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and also to direct respondents No. 4 to 8 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, accepted notice on behalf of the official respondents and Mr. Mahipal S. Yadav, Advocate accepted notice on behalf of respondent No. 4.

The parties were sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording of the statements of both the petitioners as well as of respondent No. 4 Charanjit Kaur, mother of petitioner No. 1 Manpreet Kaur. As per the statement of petitioner No. 1, she has performed the marriage with petitioner No. 2 and she wants to stay with him as his wife. Respondent No. 4 has stated that petitioner No. 1 has performed the marriage of her own wish and without the consent of respondent No. 4. She

has further stated that she will not interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners and will not extend any threat to them.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of by issuing a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievances of the petitioners for providing protection to their lives and liberty, if required.
