Petitioner-Sunny has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.94 dated 06.09.2015, registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings on 07.11.2017; his bail was cancelled and warrant of arrest was issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court due to his ailment.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that trial of the case will take a long time, therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. It is ordered that if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 10.07.2018, i.e. date already fixed before the trial Court, he shall be released on bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction.
