Petitioner is seeking protection of his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 3 and 4, who are the Superintendent of Police (Detective), Jagraon, District Ludhiana and the S.H.O. Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural. Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana Rural (Jagraon)-respondent No. 2.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana Rural (Jagraon)-respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner

and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana Rural (Jagraon)-respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
