Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to provide protection to the petitioners to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and other family members.

Respondent Nos. 4 and 5, the parents of petitioner No.1 and parents of petitioner No.2, namely, Hans Raj and Sumitra have appeared through their counsel and prayed that matter be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of settlement.

Joint statement of parents of petitioner No.1 is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

As per the statement, the parents of petitioner No.1 have stated that they will keep their daughter safely and will not cause any harm to her life and liberty. They also stated that they

will not cause any harm to her husband Raj Kumar and will not interfere in their married life. It is further stated that parents of petitioner No.1 will perform the marriage of both the petitioners as per the customs in their '*Biradari*' and will take petitioner No.1 along with them in order to perform the marriage.

The parties are ad idem that petitioner No.1 will accompany her parents in the light of statement made by them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In view of the above, petition stands disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the parties shall bound by the statement made by them.
