Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail in the light of registration of FIR No.124 dated 04.09.2017, at Police Station Gurhar Sahni, District Ferozepur, under Sections 363, 366, 376-D, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, against him.

Perusal of the FIR clearly indicates that there are specific allegations with regard to the commission of offence against the petitioner without the consent of the complainant. Petitioner has forced himself upon the complainant without her consent although it is asserted by the counsel for the petitioner that there was love affair between them.

Keeping in view the serious allegations against the petitioner, this Court does not find any ground for grant of anticipatory bail to him. The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
