AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the extent of granting protection to the lives and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6 as petitioners have threat to their lives and liberty from them. He contends that the petitioners have highlighted this position in their representation dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., P.S. Meharban, District Ludhiana-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., P.S. Meharban, District Ludhiana-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
