The present petition has been filed for release of licenced 32 bore revolver alongwith six live cartridges.

The case of the petitioner is that a dispute arose between his son and the private respondents on 29.03.2018. As a result, injuries were inflicted upon the son of the petitioner as well as the petitioner and the licensed 32 bore revolver of the petitioner was snatched alongwith six live cartridges. In this regard FIR No. 106 dated 29.03.2018 has been registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana. His apprehension is that the revolver may be misused and, therefore, it should be returned to the petitioner.

The petition is totally misconceived. There is a cross case against the petitioner as well. If the revolver has been recovered, it is case property and there is a procedure prescribed for handing over case property. No such directions can be given in a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
