The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. on account of the fact that vide order dated 12.04.2018 (Annexure P3), his bail bonds have been cancelled and non-bailable warrant of arrest has been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact, the petitioner had come to the Court premises for attending the hearing on 12.04.2018, but was picked-up by the police outside the Court premises in connection with some other case. The petitioner is not named in the other case as well and has been granted regular bail therein. Thus, the non-appearance was on account of circumstances beyond the control of the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to the petitioner to

appear before the learned trial Court/Addl. Sessions Judge (Duty) within seven days from today and seek regular bail. In case such an application is moved within the time prescribed, the petitioner shall be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Addl. Sessions Judge (Duty) concerned.
