Present petition has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR NO. 109 dated 15.05.2018 registered under Sections 379, 188, 186, 353, 307/34 IPC, Section 15 of Environment Protection Act 1986 and Section 4 of Mining Act 1952 at Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that nobody is alleged to have been injured in the incident. Learned counsel further submits that there is no other case registered against the petitioners. It is further submitted that petitioners undertake to join the investigation if they are protected against the arrest.

On instruction from ASI Davinder Kumar, Learned State counsel submits that although there is no MLR of any person showing any injury to any of the police officials. However, the allegation on the petitioners trying to run over the police personnel with their tractor trolley is a serious matter.

Since there is no injury caused to anybody, therefore in view of the above said submissions, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that petitioners shall be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
