The petitioner-Gurmantar @ Gagan Cheema, is an accused in a case under section 302 IPC in which the trial is going on. The present petition has been moved for grant of interim bail for 20 days on account of the father of the petitioner being unwell and no one else being available to look after him.

The State has filed reply dated 24.07.2018, which is taken on record. According to this reply, the father of the petitioner is suffering from *Brain Haemorrhage* and needs an attendant for daily activities and for physiotherapy. He is being examined by Neuro Surgeon as an out door patient.

Apart from the petitioner, there is one more son, who is residing abroad and there is no other male member in the family to look after health of the father.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be

released on interim bail for seven days, so that he is able to make arrangement for his father's upkeep.

In view of the above, it is directed that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of seven days on deposit of Rs.5 lacs in cash before the learned trial Court and the latter would be entitled to improve any condition subject to its satisfaction.

The petition is accordingly disposed of. The amount of Rs.5 lacs, shall be refunded in case the petitioner surrenders within prescribed period of seven days.
