GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.

Petitioner Anand Singh seeks regular bail in case FIR No.71 dated 10.02.2018 under Sections 420/467/468/471/406 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Sector-50, District Gurugram.

The FIR in the present case was lodged at the instance of M/s Toyota Finance Services, wherein it has been alleged that it had financed vehicles to customers but the customers did not repay the loan. Subsequently, it transpired that all these loan transactions were based on bogus documents and impersonation and that one Manoj used to forge documents and hand over the same to the petitioner Anand Singh and another co-accused Anand Pandey used to handover the said documents to the complainant i.e. M/s Toyota Finance Services.

During the course of investigation, all these vehicles i.e. Toyota

have been recovered. While one of the vehicle was recovered from Anand Pandey, the remaining five vehicles have been recovered from the present petitioner.

The learned DAG, Haryana has informed that the investigation is complete and challan has already been filed.

The present petitioner has been behind bars since 11.2.2018 i.e. since the last more than four and half months. No useful purpose would be served by further detaining him in judicial custody. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time. The present petition, as such, is allowed. The petitioner Anand Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate concerned.
