The sister of the petitioner was allegedly killed by her husband and his family members. An FIR has been registered in this regard. The grievance of the petitioner is that persons related to the private respondents (husband of deceased sister and his relatives) are threatening the petitioner to withdraw the case. In this regard, a representation (Annexure P6) has been submitted before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion. Mr. Surinder Pal Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to serve the other respondents, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P6) and to grant protection to the petitioner in case any threat is perceived. The needful be done within a period of eight week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
