This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed because vide order dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P3), the bail of the petitioner has been cancelled and his bail and surety bonds have been forfeited to the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner by placing reliance upon medical certificate dated 24.08.2018 (Annexure P4) submits that on the concerned date, the petitioner was admitted in the hospital. His wife appeared before the trial Court on the date fixed and moved an application for exemption, but the same was ignored by the trial Court on the ground that his bail had already been cancelled.

Keeping in view the above facts, the interest of justice would be served by directing the petitioner to surrender/appear before the trial Court/Duty Judicial Magistrate on or before 22.06.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail. In case such an application is filed before the trial Court/Duty Judicial Magistrate concerned, the latter shall granted regular bail to the petitioner to its satisfaction.
