The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the complaint dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against the private respondents, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the said complaint should be decided expeditiously.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the complaint of the petitioner within a period of four weeks, on receipt of

certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the complaint dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
