Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 13.06.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and have cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions states that recovery has been effected from the petitioners. The Investigating Officer states that a motorcycle, some clothes, two gold rings, two pair of earrings and two *kadas* have been recovered.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that a bracelet was given to the husband and a kitty set was also given which have not been recovered.

There are no pictures which show that set or bracelet was given to the petitioners.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 13.06.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
