The prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR bearing No.122 dated 29.01.2018, under Sections 379-B IPC , registered at Police Station City Panipat.

It has been contended by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that complainant Manish Sharma lodged an FIR on the premise that while going on a bike on 29.01.2018, when he reached near Nathu Sweets G.T.Road, two bikes came from behind, one out of which was a Bullet without number plate. 5-6 persons came there and asked him to stop his bike and robbed him off his mobile bearing numbers 8930300288 and 9012560148, a purse having ATM and Aadhar card, an amount of Rs. 800/- and other documents. It has been further contended that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR but being sought to be arrested by the police

on the basis of the statement of the co-accused who has been arrested. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that no useful purpose would be served from the custodial interrogation of the petitioner as investigation is already complete and challan has been presented.

Ms.Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, on instructions from ASI Prem Singh, submits that out of five accused, four have already been arrested.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the case, which will be subject matter of investigation and keeping in view the facts aforementioned, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is disposed of by granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner on the condition that he shall join the investigation as and when required by the police by issuing a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer on furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions mentioned under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
