Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.993 dated 17.9.2017, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at P.S. City Panipat District Panipat.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he by posing himself to be Jammer Operator, entered the centre for examination of conductors in Haryana Roadways in the morning shift on 17.9.2017. Petitioner was apprehended and fake Identity Card was found in his possession, which was allegedly prepared by co-accused Amarjeet for whom the petitioner came to the centre for rendering help. Apparently, the petitioner was apprehended before the act was accomplished.

The offence is triable by Magistrate.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jawahar Lal, states that challan has already been presented and even charges have been framed.

Petitioner is in custody since 17.9.2017. Trial is likely to take sometime in its culmination.

In view of above, without adverting to the merits of the case, it will be just and expedient to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Let the petitioner be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
