The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail because non-bailable warrant of arrest has been issued against him on account of non-appearance in a criminal complaint registered under Section 195 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the non-appearance was inadvertent and that he was not properly guided by his counsel before the trial Court.

Be that as it may, the petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender/appear before the trial Court on or before 18.07.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail. In case of his doing so and moving such an application, trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
