The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.76 dated 07.04.2018, registered under Sections 302, 212, 216, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Meharban, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR. However, subsequently, one of the co-accused in disclosure statement revealed that the petitioner was also accompanied them.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Joginder Pal has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 14.06.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
