By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'blanket anticipatory bail', in the event of any more FIRs being registered against her in the future, on the allegations of her having defrauded/cheated etc. any person.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Karamjeet Singh, submits that there are two FIRs already registered against the petitioner for similar offences, though she has been admitted to regular bail in both, by this Court.

Having considered the prayer of the petitioner, in my opinion, 'blanket bail' cannot be granted to her, if the allegations against her are that she and her accomplices are defrauding/cheating etc., different persons.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed, with the observation that if any other FIR is eventually registered against the petitioner, at the instance of any person aggrieved of any action that he/she alleges against her, obviously, any application/petition filed by the petitioner for bail would be decided on its own

merits, in each such case.

Further, at the time of registration of any FIR against the petitioner, as also if she is sought to be arrested, the investigating agency concerned would naturally be bound to follow due procedure of law.
