CRM No. 21873 of 2018 :

This application has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for placing on record documents as Annexures P-4 to P-7.

Application is allowed as prayed for. Documents annexed with the application are taken on record.

CRM-M No. 25934 of 2018 :

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for seeking anticipatory bail pending the FIR No. 104 dated 8.5.2018 under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Chandi Mandir, District Panchkula.

Fresh power of attorney filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pratap Singh, submits that another FIR of similar nature was also registered against the

petitioner.

Learned counsel for the complainant also submits that there is another complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act against the petitioner.
