MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (ORAL)

Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.495 dated 30.07.2016 (**Annexure P-1**), under Sections 120-B, 418, 420, 423, 465, 466, 467 and 468 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad as well as report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. dated 30.10.2017 (**Annexure P-2**) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

During the course of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition and confined his prayer only to the extent of granting exemption from personal appearance of the petitioners before learned trial Court.

Prayer seems to be justified and accepted.

In view of above, personal appearance of the petitioners during trial before learned trial Court shall remain exempted subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) *petitioners shall be represented through Counsel;*
- (ii) *shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;*
- (iii) *shall not dispute their identity as accused;*
- (iv) *shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence, but in the presence of their Counsel;*
- (v) *shall appear before learned trial Court as and when required;*
- (vi) *any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.*

It is made clear that all legal pleas, which are available to the petitioners during trial, shall remain open at the appropriate stage(s) including the objections at the time of consideration of charges by moving an application for discharge.

Dismissed as withdrawn in the above terms.
