The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 12 dated 15.9.2016, under Sections 66 and 84-B of I.T. Act, 2000 and Section 201 IPC, Police Station State Cyber Crime, District SAS Nagar Mohali and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 2.7.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of Taranpreet Singh Sidhu-complainant had been

recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter. It has specifically been reported by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali that in his opinion the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition stands allowed and FIR No. 12 dated 15.9.2016, under Sections 66 and 84-B of I.T. Act, 2000 and Section 201 IPC, Police Station State Cyber Crime, District SAS Nagar Mohali and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
