Petitioner-Khurshid has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.533 dated 31.12.2014, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh, under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 356, 186, 307 and 506 IPC (Sections 148, 149, 307 and 356 IPC deleted subsequently).

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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Learned State counsel submits that challan has already been presented against other three accused, but not against the present petitioner. He also submits that the present petitioner has been declared innocent.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 25.06.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

In view of the above facts, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 25.06.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
