Learned Counsel appearing for the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jagar Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in

two more cases also and that the petitioner in fact had given cheques to the complainant.

In reply to this, counsel for the petitioner submits that so far as the cheques are concerned, the petitioner has already filed criminal complaint qua these two cheques against three other persons regarding misuse of these cheques. That complaint was filed even before the present FIR. So far as other cases referred to by the State Counsel are concerned, counsel for the petitioner has submitted that those cases are generated against the petitioner by the police on trivial issues, not necessarily having even the criminal connotations.

The case involves only Section 420 IPC which may not involve any material recovery. Therefore, in view of the above submissions and without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
