This is a third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 302, 392, 506, 148, 149 IPC and 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot, vide FIR No.31 dated 30.03.2014.

Primarily it has been argued that case of the petitioner is on parity with Sakkattar Singh, who was accompanying the accused. According to petitioner, his role is similar in nature. However, a custody certificate has been produced by the State counsel, according to which petitioner is involved in several other cases. It appears, his earlier bail applications i.e. CRM-M-28002-2016 and CRM-M-42495-2015 were dismissed on this ground by coordinate benches. Petitioner is, thus, not entitled to concession of regular bail.

Dismissed.

Learned State counsel submits that prosecution shall endeavour to conclude its evidence at the earliest.
