This petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair,transparent investigation in case FIR No.434, dated 30.04.2018 under sections 147, 149, 323,498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra, Haryana and for protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners confines his prayer to protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners. It is submitted that a representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-4), has been submitted but no action has been taken against respondents No.4 to 8

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Ms. Mahima Yashpal, Assistant Advocate General, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 12.06.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to provide necessary protection to the petitioners in case the enquiry reveals the necessity of the same. Action be completed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
