The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty as the petitioners fear that respondents No.4 to 6 (parents and other relations of petitioner No.1) will cause them bodily harm as their marriage has been performed against their wishes.

2. Notice of motion. Ms. Ruchika Sabharwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab.

3. Petitioner No.1 is major and the same is proved by her Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1). Petitioner No.2 has also submitted his Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) showing his date of birth as 28.11.1998.

4. Be that as it may and without commenting upon the validity of the marriage between petitioners No.1 and 2, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners is protected by providing them adequate protection after carrying out a threat assessment and as and when deemed appropriate. The representation (Annexure P-4) already made as well as the facts mentioned in this petition shall be kept in mind by him.

5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
