The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0399 dated 03.12.2017 registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 22.01.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 28.01.2018 and even the DSP in the inquiry has declared the petitioner innocent and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

On instructions from ASI Resham Singh, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer

required.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
