In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.34 dated 12.07.2017 registered under Sections 302, 452, 326, 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.

2. This Court vide order dated 15.06.2018 directed the petitioners to join the proceedings and in the event of his appearance, trial Court was directed to release them on interim bail.

3. Pursuant to the order dated 15.06.2018, petitioners are stated to have approach the court below and were released on bail on 22.06.2018.

4. Accordingly, order dated 15.06.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioners shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
