This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.20, dated 16.01.2016, under sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh.

The complainant is the sister of the petitioners. She got the aforementioned FIR registered because a property inherited by the siblings, was allegedly sold by them without giving share to the complainant. During the pendency of proceedings, a compromise dated 20.05.2016 was reached, according to which the petitioners have recognised the right of the complainant to receive 1/4th of the sale consideration. Accordingly, a sum of Rs.6.5 lacs has already been paid to the complainant.

Today, a demand draft of Rs.2 lacs has been handed over to the learned counsel for the complainant. A copy of the same has been placed on record.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 30.07.2018, is hereby made absolute subject to their compliance of provisions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
