The petitioner prays for direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take appropriate action against respondent Nos.5 and 6 and to protect his life and liberty and that of his family members.

According to the petitioner, respondent Nos.5 and 6 are indulging in illegal business of prostitution at the open public places and they are threatening him and doing the same business opposite to his house. Despite repeated representations to the police, no action has been taken thereupon. A representation dated 06.06.2018 (Annexure P2) has been submitted, but to no avail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.5 and 6, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P2) and in case it is found

necessary to grant protection to the petitioner as well as his family members.
The needful be done within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of
certified copy of this order.
