The petitioner was on regular bail in Case FIR No.200 dated 21.11.2013 registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehabad, under section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985. He absented from the trial Court allegedly on the ground of ill-health and was declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 10.05.2018. The trial stood concluded and file of the case has been consigned to record room with liberty to the prosecution to revive the proceedings as and when petitioner surrenders/brought before the learned trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was involved in a motor vehicle accident, as a result of which he sustained a severe back injury and was not in a position to appear before the Court.

Be that it may so, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court on or before 02.08.2018 and seek regular bail. In case of his doing so and moving an application for regular bail, the same shall be allowed by the learned trial Court subject to its satisfaction.
