This is the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 05.06.2018 under Section 452, 427, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dirba, Distt. Sangrur

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegations as per the FIR are only pertaining to simple injuries resulting from beating. Whatsoever recoveries police intended from the petitioners, have already been made. Therefore, the petitioners are not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are granted the regular bail during pendency of the trial. They be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bond/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
