Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the proceedings before respondent No.2-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar-I, District Amritsar, are being stretched unnecessarily. He prays that a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the matter expeditiously and the petitioner would be satisfied with such direction.

Expeditious trial is a right of every litigant. Accordingly, respondent No.2-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar-I, District Amritsar, is directed to dispose of the matter expeditiously in accordance with law refraining from giving unnecessary adjournments.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition granting him an opportunity to approach the Court again, if need be.

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Dismissed as withdrawn with the observation that the petitioner may approach the Court again in accordance with law if necessity so arises.
