The present petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is allegedly being threatened by respondent Nos.4 and 5 and further not to harass the petitioner unnecessarily.

The petitioner is the owner of 200 sq. yrd. plot in Patiala District. He had agreed to sell the same to the private respondents and thereafter, a dispute has arisen between them. A suit for damages has been filed by the petitioner and after receipt of notice in the said suit, the private respondents have started harassing the petitioner.
