FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition seeking grant of anticipatory bail has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by the petitioners Sunil Sonkar and Shakuntla Devi in case registered by way of FIR No.18 dated 15.03.2018 at Police Station Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the two sides submit that the parties have effected a compromise before the Mediator and have placed reliance on report dated 16.10.2018 placed on record in original and further that the parties shall be bound by the terms of settlement arrived at between themselves.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kehar Singh from Police Station Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh submits that in consonance with the orders of interim bail dated 19.06.2018 passed by this Court the petitioners have joined the investigations and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of the amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, the stand of the State and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 19.06.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan).

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
