Petitioner-Satbir Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.171 dated 29.03.2018, registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been

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allegations in the FIR, the present petitioner introduced the complainant and his brother-in-law with main accused, Brij Bhushan @ Harsh. The money was taken by Brij Bhushan @ Harsh, not by the present petitioner. The only allegation against the present petitioner is that he introduced the complainant party with the main accused.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 20.06.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Otherwise also, neither he received the money nor misappropriated the same. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.06.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
