This petition for regular bail has been filed by petitioner –
Gurvinder Singh @ Ginder – an accused in FIR No.109 dated 5.11.2017,
under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Jhansa,
District Kurukshetra.

Briefly stated, the facts of the case as per prosecution story
are that on 5.11.2017 while being arrested by police of Police Station
Jhansa in the area of village Khanjarpur, accused was found in possession

of 9.19 gms. of heroin. He was arrested in this case. Formal FIR was registered. The petitioner had filed application for regular bail in the Court of Sessions, which was declined by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra vide order dated 5.1.2018, as such, he has approached this Court with same request.

Notice of the petition was given to respondent – State and counsel representing the State has put in appearance.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties besides going through the record.

Keeping in view the nature and quantity of the contraband recovered from the petitioner and the fact that he is involved in three more cases under NDPS Act bearing FIR No.72 dated 30.10.2012, under Section 21 NDPS Act, Police Station Badli Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, FIR No.117 dated 10.8.2014, under Section 18 of NDPS Act, Police Station City, Sirhind and FIR No.51 dated 14.6.2017, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra, he does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

The drug trafficking is rising at an alarming rate in this region, which has ruined the lives of young men and women. Drug peddlers for a small monetary consideration make the youth to use drugs for a small time excitement/kick. The drug peddlers have successfully destroyed the social fabric of our society and led youth to the wrongful path. Such type of persons need to be dealt with firmly and sternly and no sympathy can be shown to them lest that should prove to be counter productive and result in increased drug trafficking.

Therefore, finding no merit in the petition, the same stands dismissed.
