Petitioner-Palwinder Singh @ Rahul has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.132 dated 15.08.2017, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 452, 323, 325, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He was stated to be armed with iron rod. Three simple injuries on the head, thigh and waist of complainant-Pooja Kumar have been attributed to him, which falls under Section 323 IPC. The grievous injury under Section 325 IPC has been attributed to co-accused Paramjit Kaur.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 10.01.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 10.01.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
